Partners' research has shown that 76% of congregation-supported community programs are located in sacred places. Additionally, 81% of those who use these programs *are not members* of the host congregation. Left unsupported, these buildings – as well as the health and vitality of congregations and community outreach – suffer and decline.

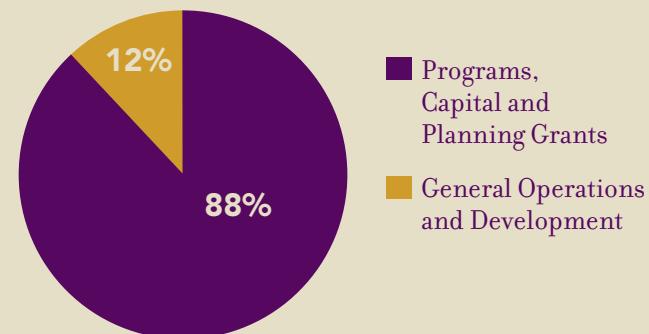


